FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Mr. Pierroz briefly described the financial statements as of September 30, 2022. The P&L is \$100K in the negative for 2022. We expect to break even or be slightly in the red as of year-end unless there is another closing by the end of the year. With inflation and the interest rates, we are overall pleased with the year.

GENERAL BUSINESS UPDATE

Susan Morth stated we lost three closings with the same capital provider due to interest rate increases, one in Essex County, one in Skaneateles and one in Wyndham. We facilitated a \$33M multifamily project in New Rochelle with Enhanced Capital. Ms. Morth stated Dan Killourhy, former EIC Treasurer & Comptroller, will be replacing Kim Kowalski as Board Secretary.

Ms. Hoenig stated this is an impressive year financially since there was no grant funding this year.
